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OUTDOOR PLAY: Spring has arrived and while the weather is warmer it is important that



the children have the proper clothing for outdoor play.

Each child must have sneakers and a light coat or

<u>sweater</u>. Children will not be allowed to play outside if they cannot be properly dressed.

Outdoor Temperature Policy

We will be able to enjoy outdoor play when the temperature is between 30' and 85' Fahrenheit. For cold temperatures we will factor in wind chill and for hot

temperatures we will factor in the heat index. For the temperatures in the lower and upper



when inclement weather conditions are forecast.



The following are **Reading Tips** from the website Reading Rockets.

- Read together every day. Make this a warm and loving time.
- **Give everything a name.** This helps build your child's vocabulary.
- Say how much you enjoy reading. Talk about "story time" as the favorite part of the day.
- Read with fun in your voice. Use humor, expression and different voices.
- Know when to stop. Put the book away for awhile if your child loses interest or is having trouble paying attention.
- **Be interactive.** Discuss what's happening in the book, point out things on the page and ask questions.
- Read it again and again. Repetition is one of the first steps in learning how to read
- Talk about writing, too. Mention how we read from left to right and how words are separated by spaces.
- Point out print everywhere. Talk about the written words you see in the world around you.
- Get your child evaluated. Always talk with your child's pediatrician if you have concerns about their language development, hearing or sight.
