WINTER WEATHER has arrived and this affects the children's outerwear needs for outdoor play. For outside play during the winter

months, each child must have sneakers or winter boots, gloves/mittens, a coat and hat. When there is snow on the ground, boots and snow pants are required. Children will not be allowed to play outside if they cannot be properly dressed.

NOTE: Scotty's policy is to not take the children outside when the temperature or the temperature with wind chill factored in falls below 30°F. We will also cancel outdoor play when extreme weather conditions are forecast.

ANNUAL FLU SHOT: Connecticut State Regulations require that all children ages 6 to 59 months attending a day care and/or preschool facility receive an annual influenza vaccine. We have

passed out the flu shot reminder form to all families and have started to receive some back already. REMEMBER that your child's flu shot must be done before December 13th and the signed form returned to us. Thank you to all of the families that have turned in the completed form.

### THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT



Department of Public Health requires that all children who attend day care be immunized. This includes their annual flu shot. CT State Day Care Licensing

Regulations mandate that a current health assessment record be in your child's day care file.

This means that a new Early Childhood Health Assessment Record form must be filled out and turned in to us each time your child visits the doctor for his/her wellness visits/physicals.

It is required that the Parents fill out and sign Part I on page 1 of the form prior to visiting the doctor.

The doctor must fill out and sign Part II on pages 2 and 3.

Please be sure to review the form before leaving the doctor's office to be sure that they have completed the form, especially that they have:

- filled in the date of the exam pg 2
- filled in the Medical Evaluation section pg2
- filled in the TB Risk section pg 2
- filled in the Developmental Assessment section pg 2
- filled in the Immunizations section pg 2
- signed the form pg 2
- filled out and initialed the Immunization Record pg 3

(note that a printout of the doctor's Immunization record form is acceptable in place of page 3)

## No incomplete forms can be accepted.

The forms are available for you here at Scotty's, or on our website (www.scottyskiddykorner.com) under the 'Parent Korner' tab. We are happy to show you what information is required on the form.



Per the State of Connecticut, we are required to conduct monthly fire drills, as well as other safety drills throughout the year. The staff and children have done exceedingly well during these drills.

If by chance, you are in the building when an evacuation happens, either stay with your child and exit with their class, or leave the child in the care of the teacher and exit the building to your vehicle. If you get into your car, please DO NOT move your vehicle. Children are coming from all exit doors to their designated safe spot on the other side of the parking lot near Lower Butcher Rd. and will be returning to the building the same way so we need to exercise extreme caution.

If you are trying to arrive when an evacuation is in place, please **DO NOT** enter the parking lot. A staff member will be located at each entrance of the parking lot to stop you in the driveway until the drill is over.

If you are in your parked vehicle and an evacuation is occurring, please DO NOT take your child until the classes have officially been released to reenter the building. You may join your child and their class, but you will not be allowed to leave until the official release. Please DO NOT move your vehicle until all children have returned to the building.

We thank you for your cooperation. The safety of our staff and children is our top priority. Please let us know if you have any questions.
