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Health & Wellness

We have handed out new **Topical Medication Forms** for each child and ask that if you haven't already, please fill out and sign this form so that your child can have sunscreen applied here at Scotty's. Once you have filled out and signed the form, return it to Lillian or your child's teacher along with a bottle of **new sunscreen, labeled with your child's name**, so we can protect them during outdoor play. *Old sunscreen cannot be accepted as sunscreen does expire.*



For outside play during the Spring months, **each child must have a light coat and sneakers**. Children won't be allowed to play outside if they cannot be properly dressed. Weather conditions can change quickly during the Summer, so please check the forecast so that you can provide the proper outer wear for your child each day.

PERSONAL TOYS & BOOKS

We remind parents to help us enforce our no personal toys and books policy. This includes any play jewelry. We provide many toys and books here at Scotty's that are easier to share with others than toys and books from home. Children are allowed to have one item to sleep with at nap time that can be kept in their cubby. Scotty's does provide special days for children to bring in a special toy or book to show their friends. These special days are marked on the calendar when they are scheduled.

TRY THIS AT HOME

Have you ever wanted more ways to incorporate **Academic Skills** at home? The following idea from Brookes Publishing Co. is a great way to make math fun.

Create a Dedicated Writing Center

To make writing/prewriting activities inviting to young children, designate a table or desk as your home's "writing center." Fill it with open-ended materials that invite exploration and experimentation. Offer kids blank paper in different colors, a small dry erase board, markers, crayons, pencils, scissors, glue sticks, hole punches, and envelopes. Kids who have a variety of materials on hand will be more likely to initiate self-directed writing projects.
