Thanksgiving - Nov 27-28

Scotty's is closed on Thu, Nov 27th & Fri, Nov 28th in observance of Thanksgiving. Full tuition is due the week of Nov 24.

Christmas Observance - Dec 25-26

Scotty's will be closed Thu, Dec 25th & Fri, Dec 26th in observance of Christmas. Full tuition is due the week of Dec 22.

Christmas Observance - Dec 24th

Scotty's will have a half day and close at 1:00pm on Wednesday, December 24th in observance of Christmas. Full tuition is due the week of Dec 22.

Winter Vacation Shutdown

Scotty's will be closed the week of December 29th thru January 2nd for our Winter Vacation Shutdown. No tuition is due the week of December 29.



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Health & Wellness



IT'S GETTING COLDER: and Parents should change over their child's extra clothing, that they have here for emergencies, to warmer seasonally appropriate clothing. Also, each child is required to bring a coat/jacket and sneakers for outdoor play in the colder weather. If there is snow on the ground, children will need snow boots to go outside. Children are not permitted to participate in outdoor play unless they have a coat/jacket and sneakers/boots.



ANNUAL FLU SHOT: Connecticut State Regulations require that all children ages 6 to 59 months attending a day care and/or preschool facility receive an annual influenza vaccine. We have passed out the flu shot reminder form to all families and have started to receive some back already. REMEMBER that your child's flu shot must be done before December 12th and the signed form returned to us. Thank you to all of the families that have turned in the completed form.



THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT

Department of Public Health requires that all children who attend day care be immunized. This includes their annual flu shot. CT State Day Care Licensing Regulations mandate that a current health assessment record be in your child's day care file. This means that a new **Early Childhood Health Assessment Record** form must be filled out and turned in to us each time your child visits the doctor for his/her wellness visits/physicals. It is required that the Parents fill out and sign Part I on page 1 of the form prior to visiting the doctor.



The doctor must fill out and sign Part II on pages 2 and 3.

Please be sure to review the form before leaving the doctor's office to be sure that they have completed the form, especially that they have:

- filled in the date of the exam - pg 2
- filled in the Medical Evaluation section - pg2
- filled in the TB Risk section - pg 2
- filled in the Developmental Assessment section - pg 2
- filled in the Immunizations section - pg 2
- signed the form - pg 2
- filled out and initialed the Immunization Record - pg 3

(note that a printout of the doctor's Immunization record form is acceptable in place of page 3)

No incomplete forms can be accepted.

TRY THIS AT HOME FAMILY TIME

Can I help?

Need an extra pair of helping hands? Look no further than your little one. Here are ways you can build on his eagerness to help out and teach him skills for the future

Say yes. When your youngster asks to let him help you, let him, even if you the job is too hard for him. Just look for a small part he can tackle. Maybe he could shake pillows out of pillowcases when you're changing the sheets, for example.

Be patient. Allow your child to work at his own pace. Sure, it might take a little longer for him to load all the bowls into the dishwasher. But the sense of accomplishment he'll feel is worth a few extra minutes.

Offer a hand. If you notice your youngster struggling, ask if he needs help rather than take over. But be prepared to let him work things out on his own if he turns you down.

Praise effort. Thank your child for his help, and point out how he makes a difference. ("We got the towels folded a lot faster, thanks to your hard work!") You'll make him feel proud and motivate him to keep helping.
