OUTDOOR PLAY: Spring has arrived and while the weather is warmer it is important that the children have the proper clothing for outdoor play. Each child must have sneakers and a light coat or sweater.



Children will not be allowed to play outside if they cannot be properly dressed.

Outdoor Temperature Policy

We will be able to enjoy outdoor play when the temperature is between 30° and 85° Fahrenheit. For cold temperatures we will factor in wind chill and for hot temperatures we will factor in the heat index.

For the temperatures in the lower and upper ranges of our policy we will adjust play times and hydration requirements. **Outdoor play may be cancelled when inclement weather conditions are forecast.**
